STEPS:

- 1. Decide what the potential consequence would be if an employee were to be injured performing the task or using the particular piece of equipment.
- 2. Decide the likelihood of the employee being injured performing the task or using the particular piece of equipment.
- 3. Follow the columns until they meet with the outcome of the risk level being extreme, high, medium, or low.
- 4. Complete Job Hazard Analyses on tasks or equipment in the following order:
 - I. Extreme
 - II. High
 - III. Medium
 - IV. Low
