Authorized Use of School-Owned Materials and Equipment

AP: 502

Authorized Use of School-Owned Materials and Equipment

School-owned materials may, at the discretion of the principal, be loaned to a local organization.

School equipment may be loaned to community groups for educational, civic or charitable purposes when:

- 1. The group borrowing the equipment agrees to accept responsibility for repairing or replacing any equipment damaged or lost while in its possession.
- 2. The equipment is not unusually expensive and subject to easy damage.
- 3. The equipment is in good condition.
- 4. The group will provide a competent operator for any machine loaned.
- 5. Outside use of the equipment will not interfere with the school program.

Any student or other individual borrowing school equipment must sign an official receipt. A deposit may be required as determined by the principal, or the Division's Administration.

School principals shall have the responsibility of allocating the use and storage of jointly owned (school-community) materials.
