## **School Catchment Guidelines**

School catchment areas in the Park West School Division are established to assist with planning and administration. Students are expected to attend in their catchment area or designated school. (Please see the maps on our divisional website at <a href="www.pwsd.ca">www.pwsd.ca</a> in the Bus Information tab.)

### **School of Choice**

Parents wishing to enroll their children at a school other than their area or designated school must submit the prescribed Provincial School of Choice form to the principal of the receiving school by May 15<sup>th</sup> prior to September enrollment. Registrations will only be accepted after January 10<sup>th</sup> for students who are school eligible in September of that year.

Parents and students are further advised that although a request for School of Choice is granted existing bus routes will not be changed to accommodate this request. Parents will be responsible to transport the student to the nearest existing pick up point.

## **Class Size Guidelines for School of Choice Applications**

All School of Choice applications for Park West School Division schools are subject to the following class size guidelines.

Kindergarten to Grade 8:

- 20 student cap size based on June 1 enrollment.
- Once these class size numbers have been reached, only students in the catchment area will be automatically enrolled

School of Choice students may be admitted upon consideration of:

- Available physical space
- Class size and demographics allow for the addition of new students
- Accessible special equipment, special facilities and programs required by the student
- Program suitability and continuity with respect to age, ability, and student's aptitude.
- School safety and other risk factors.
- Timeline for proper notification.

The school principal, in consultation with the superintendent, may allow additional school-of-choice students beyond the recommended class size cap on a case-by-case basis. This assumes that the considerations listed above yield no concerns.

### **Admission Priorities:**

The priority of the division for admission for School of Choice students are as follows:

- Resident students from within the Park West School Division, in order of the date of initial receipt of the application at the school. Registrations will only be accepted after January 10<sup>th</sup> for students who are school eligible in September of that year.
- 2. Non-resident students, in order of the date of initial receipt of the application at the school.
- 3. Additional consideration may be given for non-resident students who have siblings already attending the school.

## **Special Needs**

There may be times when special arrangements will need to be made in order to accommodate special needs students. Such requests for special consideration will need to be identified in the student's IEP plan. Requests of this nature must come from the Student Services Coordinator.
